New & Renovated Features:

- Interior renovations and upgrades:
 - Career and technical education spaces
 - Early College Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) classrooms
 - Science labs
- Demolition of the Anthony Wing
- Roof replacement
- Right of way improvements
- Electrical, mechanical and plumbing upgrades
- Accessibility improvements
- Exterior envelope, structural and basement repairs



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Phase I: Scope

Bid Package #1 – Renovation (~ 85,000SF Interior Program + MEP Upgrades + Site Development)

- All interior scope included but not limited to: Navistar, Carpentry, Allied Health, Horticulture, CTE programs, Cosmetology, Culinary, Early College STEM (ECS) spaces & Science Labs
- MEP upgrades to service CTE programs
- Full Roof Replacement w/parapet and Cap termination including raised roof equipment: Knuckle, 87th and Chappel Wings
- Limited [ADA] American Disabilities Act Accessible Improvements
- Structural repairs at 87th Wing Gymnasium
- Exterior Façade Restoration repairs/renovation (Including structural repairs)
- [PROW] Right of Way Improvements: Curbs and Sidewalks, ADA curb ramps, Driveways, Parkways, Ornamental Fencing, and Landscaping
- [CDOT] Chicago Depart of Transportation improvements: Street Signage, Street Lighting, Traffic Signal Management
- Site Landscape & Civil scope
- Central Plant Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Systems Upgrades
 & for building programs (Incl. Abatement)
- Basement repairs (Plenum, access, ceilings, electrical, lighting etc.)
- Building Heating System Start
- MEP Commissioning [March 2015], Air Conditioning to CTE programs



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Phase II: Scope

Bid Package #2 – Abatement & Demolition (~ 150,000 SF Building + Site Development + Greenhouse)

- Full Abatement Only of the two-story plus basement building of the Anthony Wing
- Demolition only of the two-story plus basement building of the Anthony Wing
- Façade enclosure work at link to knuckle
- Site Civil storm water management and service drive (After Anthony Wing building demolition)
- CTE Greenhouse w/associated site work and Learning Garden (After A-Wing building demolition)
- Landscaping and Site restoration (After Anthony Wing building demolition)




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


Phasing Plan








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
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LOWER LEVEL FLOOR PLAN



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GROUND LEVEL FLOOR PLAN




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SECOND LEVEL FLOOR PLAN







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Schedule



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Phase I: Schedule

- Bid on Jan 17, 2014; Estimated Construction from Feb 2014 to Jan 2015
 - Substantial completion milestone 1/Interior renovation program: August 2014
 - Substantial completion milestone 2/MEP and exterior: Mid December 2014

Phase II: Schedule

- Bid in Jul 2014, Estimated Construction from Jan 2015 to Sept 2015
 - Substantial completion of demolition work: August 2015

Work Site Employment Requirements


• The PBC requires that General Contractors commit to a construction work site employment program that addresses the following employment goals:

WORKFORCE	PROJECT EMPLOYMENT GOAL
City of Chicago Residents	50% of construction work hours to be performed by City of Chicago Residents
Community Residents	7.5% of construction work hours to be performed by residents of the "Project Community" designated for each Project
Student Interns	8 students

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Commitment to Sustainable Development for the Environment

- Diversion of construction waste from landfills
- Utilization of durable and recycled materials in construction
- Reflective roofs
- Occupancy light sensors/controls
- High efficiency heating and cooling systems
- Low flow/low consumption water usage
- Native and adaptive landscape species
- Aggressive storm water management



Commitment to Economic Sustainability Programs for the Community

Programs Include:

- Bid incentives for the employment of apprentices
- Bid incentives for the employment of minority and female workers
- Contract provisions that require at least 50% of the labor force be residents of the City of Chicago
- Contract provisions with regard for community hiring, helping to employ those closest to the work at hand
- Contract provisions that require minority- and women-owned business participation
- Contract provisions for local business participation
